## WE ARE ON THE CUSP OF A CLIMATE SAFE WORLD

BUT because we are not moving fast enough to cut carbon emissions, we are facing a catastrophic climate and nature crisis.

Even if all of the current pledges of governments, corporations, and investments are fully implemented, we are not on course for a liveable world. 11

## WE ARE NOT SEEING THE URGENCY

#### Right now, the climate crisis

Kills more people than HIV, Tuberculosis, and Malaria combined.

Kills more people than COVID-19 has in three years.

Kills 5 million people due to extreme temperature fluctuation.

Will displace 1.2 billion people globally by 2050.



# WOMEN AND GIRLS ARE SUFFERING THE MOST

## The climate crisis is unfair. The people that do the least to cause it are suffering the most, especially women and girls.

Extreme weather events such as droughts and floods have a greater impact on the poor and most vulnerable, and 70% of the world's poor are women.

It is estimated that 80% of people displaced by climate change are women.

Women are 14 times more likely to die in a climate-related disaster than men.

## WHEN WOMEN LEAD, ACTION FOLLOWS

Where women have higher social and political status, their countries have 12% lower CO2 emissions.

Nations with larger proportions of women in their legislatures are more likely to approve environmental agreements.

When more women are involved in group decisions about land management, the group conserves more.

The presence of women in conservation and natural resource management has resulted in stricter and more sustainable extraction rules, greater compliance, more transparency and accountability, and better conflict resolution.

Women adopt innovative and preventative measures for their communities at a faster rate than men.

**The Empowered** - they lead, they get involved, and they are loyal to the end

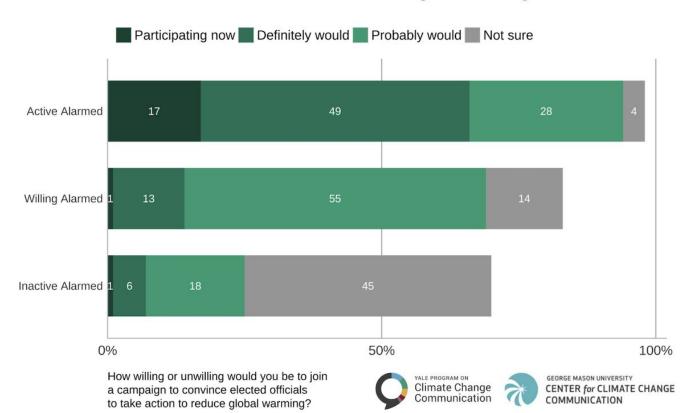
**The Wise Ones** - they've been protesting since the 60s and 70s and have seen real change enacted in their lifetime

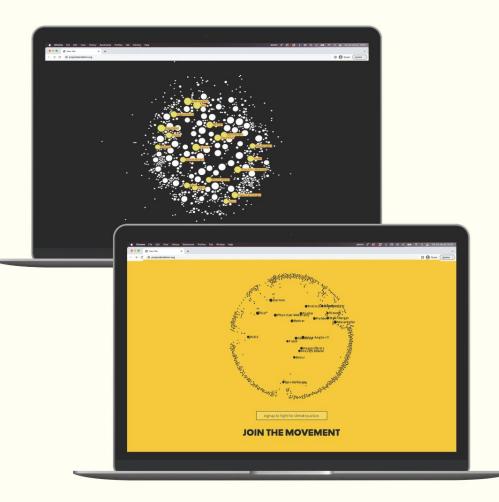










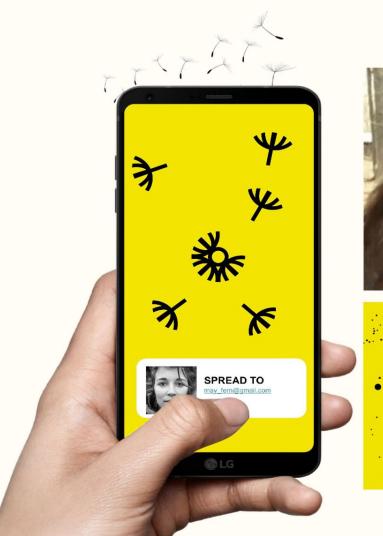

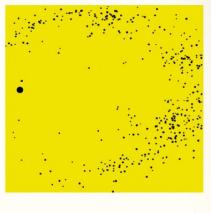
